Our first visit of the day was to The Lace Gallery where we viewed various examples of the Lace which has become world famous and put Carrickmacross on the map. We were given a short account of the origins of the lace and shown the intricacies of manufacture of



this very delicate and beautiful material. We then repaired to the Shirley Arms Hotel where a nourishing lunch was enjoyed before embarking on our second visit of the day, to Carrickmacross Workhouse. Our visit to the Workhouse was greatly enhanced by our guide Bernie, who imparted her tremendous knowledge of the site, its history, the conditions of those who dwelt and laboured and also those who died there. We visited the women's dormitory experiencing a little of the harsh conditions that existed and we also viewed a very moving audio visual depicting the realities of Workhouse life.
